



Distribution of referrals by Quintile of Deprivation


Referrals Jul 20 - Dec 20, Dec MDS



 Since delivering our NDPP2 contracts (July 2019), the proportion of individual's from the most deprived quintile (IMD1) has increased.

Distribution of referrals by Age and Framework


Referrals Jul 20 - Dec 20, Dec 20 MDS



- 59% of referrals received during F2 in 2020 were for individuals under 65 years of age, which is up 1% from F1.
- F2 had significantly higher proportions of referrals in the 18-64 age group (+6%).




Percentage of referrals who attended at least one intervention session by framework and by month of referral Dec 2020 MDS




- 1. NDPP2 (red line) saw a higher uptake when compared to NDPP1.
- 2. Further increased uptake was observed in March with remote implementation, which illustrates how remote delivery increased accessibility and desirability of the remote offer i.e. those frightened to be in group situations due to COVID and remote felt safer.
- 3. Similarly, this made the service more accessible to all patients, such as those in rural locations who could not access the service without waiting for critical group mass.





Retention for those who have finished the programme By Session and Framework.



When comparing NDPP2 retention between providers, Xyla H&W (previously ICS H&W) rank first with over 40% of patients still retained at Session 13.











Retention for those who have had time to finish the programme By Session and Framework





 It is a similar picture with our digital provider Oviva, who also rank first with retention rates.



Patient Satisfaction

- 88% of patients said the NDPP helped them improve their exercise habits
- 94% of patients said the NDPP helped them improve their diet/eating habits
- 96% of patients said they felt more positive for having attended the NDPP
- 99% of patients would recommend the NDPP to other people who are identified as being at risk of Type 2 Diabetes.

- Taking charge





